<p><u>Non-Emergency</u> (619) 531-2000 or (858) 484-3154</p>	<p><u>To San Diego Police Department Communications</u> 24 hours – 7 days To report a crime, a person you suspect of “casing” cars or homes, cars drag racing past your home at midnight, etc.</p>
